- We will have hand pump sanitizer stations as you walk into the dining hall as well as down at the Big River grill and the Moose store. Everyone that comes into the dining hall for meals will be asked to use the sanitizer or wash their hands at our sinks.
- We will expand outdoor dining all over the area below our main campus dining hall with tables, chairs and benches spread out. Our hope is that at least 75 percent of our guests will choose to dine outside.
- We will always use disposable plates, cups, and utensils
- Our food service lines will have sneeze guards
- Every Riverview staff, when they are involved with food service will wear a mask.
- Twice a day Riverview staff will go throughout the campus spraying down and wiping all doorknobs, door handles, toilets, hand railings, sinks, drinking fountains.
- For the last 10 years Riverview has cleaned every mattress, sink, countertop with disinfecting wipes. Nothing changes for us this year as we will continue to do this before every group arrives.
- Our kitchens fall under the jurisdiction of the health dept. Because of that we have been held to an extremely high standard for our kitchens and dining services. We will continue to keep and meet that high standard.
